

MMAP Awarded Top Promising Practice

Multiple Measures Assessment was awarded the top promising practice for students in developmental courses within IES's What Work's Clearinghouse; in fact, two of the MMAP user guides were [cited as resources](#).

The approaches used by the MMAP Research Team in Phase I and Phase II were also highlighted as models to use to develop predictive models: logistic regression and classification and regression tree analysis in the REL-South East publication: [A Guide to Developing and Evaluating a College Readiness Screener](#).
