Webinar Series: Quantitative Leap! **Improving the Targeting of Treatment: Emerging** **Research on Postsecondary Math Placement Policies** **Wednesday, June 8, 11:00 am - 12:15 pm**

This is the second webinar in the series,
"Quantitative Leap: How Math Policies can
Support Transitions To and Through College."

Recent research on college remediation has revealed the limitations of traditional placement tests and practices for accurately measuring the capacity of students in mathematics. These limitations raise the possibility that large proportions of college students are being under-placed and required to repeat courses they've successfully completed in high school, delaying, or deterring their progress to a degree. Some higher education institutions are developing new assessment policies with a goal of improving math readiness, college success, and equality in student outcomes.
